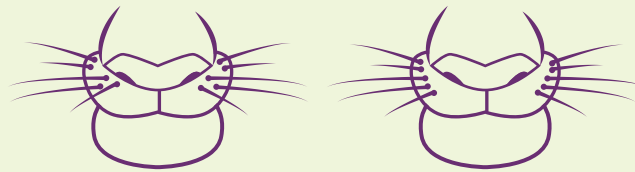


Patterns in Nature

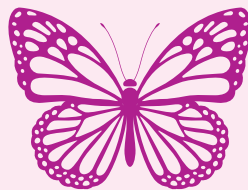

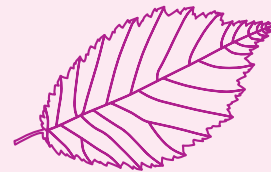
BE INSPIRED BY THE PATTERNS YOU SEE IN NATURE, LIKE:



The timber in a tree

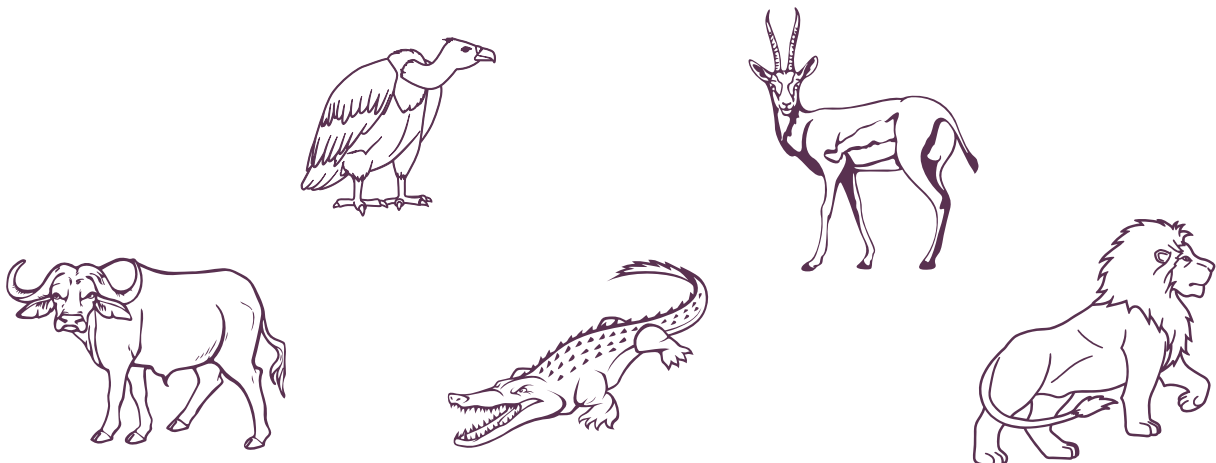


The patterns on the wings of a butterfly
